What are the Benefits of Being a Participant in Learning, Leading & Serving?

DEGREE DISCOUNT FOR STAFF. Exclusive **10% degree discount** for PLLS faculty and staff on tuition for undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at Grand Canyon University (GCU).*

CONTINUING EDUCATION/SINGLE COURSE DISCOUNT. Individual courses from GCU's degree programs, along with a portfolio of six-week online continuing education classes, are offered at a 10% discount to PLLS staff.*

DEGREE DISCOUNT FOR SPOUSES. Exclusive **5% degree discount** for PLLS member spouses, providing savings toward tuition and fees for online undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.*

DEGREE DISCOUNT FOR PARENTS. Exclusive **5% degree discount** for PLLS parents on tuition for undergraduate or graduate degree programs through the GCU College of Education or a doctoral degree related to the field of education.*

GRAND CANYON STATE UNIVERSITY GRANT. Students attending an Arizona high school that is a PLLS member will have access to a \$1,000 GCU grant. The grant is divided into \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester as long as the student maintains the minimum GPA requirements.**

COHORTS. PLLS members may request that cohorts be developed for continuing education, individual courses and/or degree programs on GCU's campus, online or at an approved PLLS site or regionally approved GCU site.

DUAL ENROLLMENT. PLLS members will have access to a catalog of dual enrollment courses for their high school students, offering them an opportunity to reduce the time to complete a bachelor's degree from four years to three. **This could reduce college costs by up to 25%.**

EDSOURCE. PLLS members will receive access to GCU's EDSOURCE services. Available EDSOURCE opportunities include: Speakers Bureau (motivational speaking and lectures), Professional Development (instruction based on specific subject matter and customized to address specific needs), and Coaching, Mentoring and Consultation (individualized assistance in areas requested).

STUDENT TEACHING/PRACTICUM PRIORITY PLACEMENT. PLLS members requesting student teaching/practicum placements of GCU teacher candidates receive priority.

EVENT DISCOUNTS. PLLS members will receive priority communication about events on GCU's campus, including discounted ticket opportunities.

GCU FACILITIES. PLLS member schools will receive priority access to GCU facilities, subject to availability. If there is a charge for any facility use, PLLS members will receive a significant discount.

EVENTS/OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS. GCU offers a number of opportunities throughout the school year for your students to experience our vibrant campus life. Additionally, GCU staff members are available to visit your campus to share information about college and career readiness.

Grand Canyon University CAP Policy: GCU grants are allowed to be combined up to the following limits: Chancellor IB/President's Scholars in campus housing—up to \$16,500; all other scholars in campus housing—up to \$14,000; all scholars living off campus—up to \$11,500.
